(EYFS) Curriculum Overview – Autumn Term 2025

Dear families

It has been wonderful to welcome old and new faces into our very exciting EYFS classroom. Below you will find key information regarding EYFS.

Additional Information / Reminders:

- **PE:** Outdoor PE kit will be required in school all week. Please bring it in a clearly labelled bag every Monday, where it can remain in school until Friday. Children are not allowed to wear earrings, so please ensure these are removed or that your child can take them out themselves.
- Nursery will not be expected to bring PE kit but we would ask that you send your child in clothing appropriate for activities of this nature. Therefore, we kindly ask you send your child in trainers on Monday and Thursday.
- Reception will take part in PE on Monday afternoon and Thursday morning. PE kit will be sent back on either Thursday or Friday ready for the new week.
- The PE kit is a white t-shirt, black shorts, trainers and during the cooler months; black joggers and jackets.
- **Reading Books:** should be taken home and brought back to school each day. The children would benefit from reading every day and we thank you for your support with this. To begin with, Reception children will bring home a 'Book for Pleasure'. This book is not at their reading ability and is only to be enjoyed as such. You can support your children by seeing if your child can recognize any sounds they are currently working on but will not be expected to read these books. Updates on reading books will be sent once your child has been taught the first unit of sounds.
- **Names on Uniform:** To help keep track of the children's school uniforms and water bottles, please ensure names are clearly written on their shoes, jumpers, cardigans, tops, trousers, water bottles and hats.
- **Winter Weather:** As the weather is very unpredictable, please ensure your children have coats with them. This allows the children to enjoy outdoor learning.
